Additional Notes

- The \$80 REC/IM FEE/SEMESTER (Fall/Winter/Summer) ~ is included in estimates, and students may opt out of this fee
- All undergraduate students pay the same tuition for undergraduate level courses, regardless of residency status
- The graduate resident tuition rate is exclusively charged to Michigan residents, while all other U.S. residents and international students are charged the non-resident graduate tuition rate
- Graduate students are not charged an online fee for graduate level courses
- Within the range provided, lower cost estimates are for on-campus students who do not pursue a thesis
- Within the range provided, higher cost estimates are for distance online students who pursue a thesis
- Tuition estimates are assessed annually, based on university tuition rates as approved by Board of Regents each summer
- Tuition may be higher or lower based on which courses are offered online for on-campus students, and this is to be determined in the future
- Estimates are for five-semester Program courses only (not prerequisites, etc.)
- The Program has provided estimated incidental costs in addition to the tuition and fees charged by the University; see page titled Estimated Incidental Costs.
- Tuition and fees generally increase every year
